

**Bagging Procedures updated 11/07/07**  
**New bagging chairpersons**

In an effort to accommodate all students interested in bagging, a new policy has been created and subsequently approved by the Executive Board. The following are the new features in the Bagging Policy.

1. Students will work a 2 hour shift and there are 20 spots per bagging.
2. Sign ups will continue to be via phone to **Cheryl Dunn @ 732-833-1588** or by email to **Kelley Dippold @ [dipboberin@msn.com](mailto:dipboberin@msn.com)** or by sign up at the previous band parent meeting.
3. **The hours for the phone calls will be from 9am to 9 pm on the first day of the month or at the previous Band Parent Meeting. Some months will not have a call in date, check the website.**
4. Students who have not bagged the prior month will be pulled before students who have bagged the month before.
5. The bagging will be pulled for each month, except where the bagging is before the band parent meeting or too close to the first of the month.
6. In cases where siblings are scheduled on the same date, they will be scheduled on the same shift.
7. You will need to call in/email or sign up at the prior band parent meeting for each bagging, the chair persons will announce if they are pulling for 2 months, in case the following month occurs before the band parent meeting or too close to the first of the month to wait.
8. The bagging chair person is responsible for contacting the parent/student as to the day and time of the shift they are scheduled for.
9. It is hoped that parents of scheduled students will volunteer to chaperone at the time of their student's shift.
10. Bagging dates will be listed on the website.
11. **If you cannot make the scheduled bagging please call one of the chair people and let them know as soon as possible. IF you do not call to let them know and do not show up for your scheduled bagging time, you will not be included in the next bagging date. Emergencies happen, please just let them know.**

**Please wear tan or black pants, red band polo shirt, and closed shoes.** The use of cell phones or Ipods while bagging is not permitted. Drinks or food are not allowed at the register. These fundraisers are very important and we need to keep them. **Please remind your child to act appropriately while bagging!**
